Mini-Nuke 2: Motion to allow research of low-yield nuclear weapons, but prohibit development and testing. FAILED 12-13

RNEP: Motion to prohibit the Secretary of Energy from beginning development of the Robust Nuclear Earth Penetrator (RNEP), unless each phase is specifically authorized by Congress. FAILED 12-13
