The U.S. has used cluster munitions in the civilian populated areas of three countries in the last ten years. Bishop Desmond Tutu, the International Committee of the Red Cross, UNICEF, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the Christian relief group World Vision have all called for a ban on cluster bombs. More than 130 countries have also agreed to work for a global treaty this year to restrict the use of these weapons.

Urge your Senators and Representative to support the Cluster Munition Civilian Protection Act (S. 594/H.R. 1755). By doing so, they will help align U.S. policy with that of its allies.
