

# 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Cluster Bomb

Cluster bombs leave behind landmine-like submunitions, which threaten, wound and kill people long after war has ended. Children aged 5-15 are particularly prone to pick up these curious looking objects. More than half the world's nations are gathering in Dublin, Ireland on May 19-30 to negotiate a ban on these weapons. Our government won't be there. The U.S. is historically the largest producer, exporter and user of cluster weapons.

Come out and have some fun while raising awareness about what it's like to live with cluster bombies all around—like millions of kids do.\* Speak out for them!

### Games include

- Bocce bomb (roll your bomb close, but not too close...)
- Cluster bomb relay race: run and pass your "cluster bomb" to your team mate on a spoon; you drop it you really lose!
- Cluster bomb hop-scotch (it's a minefield!)
- Cluster bomb scavenger hunt: some are deadly, some aren't—just like in real life

Bring food and picnic for peace!

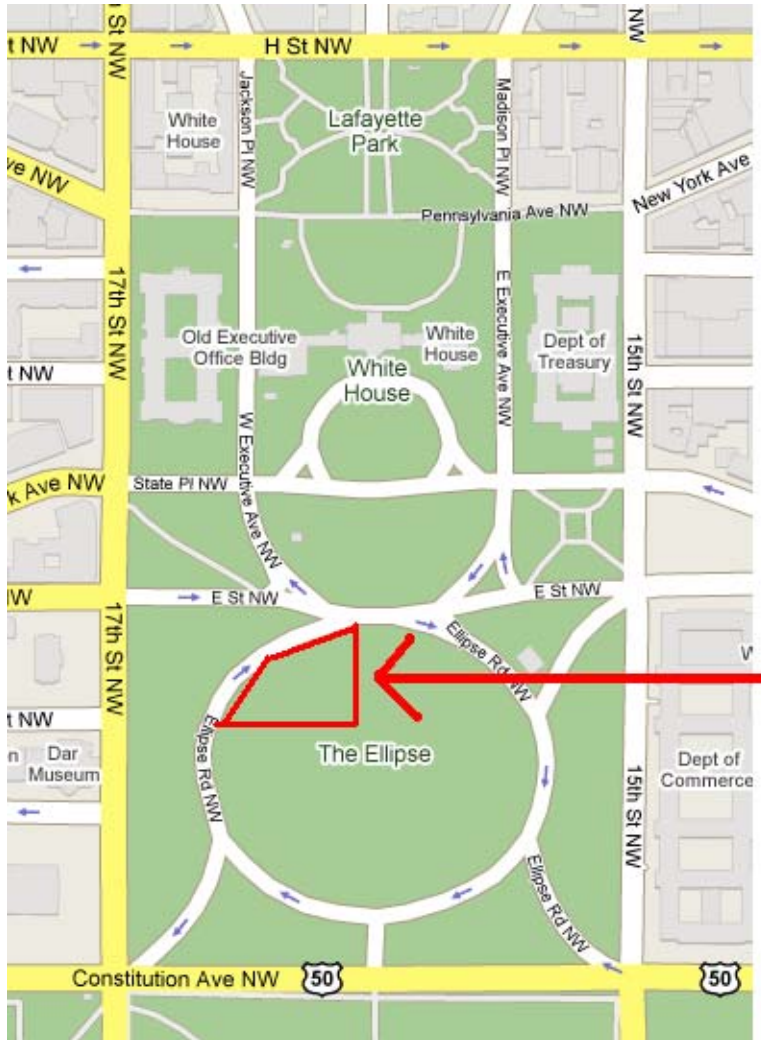

## Nearest Metro Stations

Farragut West (Orange/Blue Line) Take the 17<sup>th</sup> St. NW exit and walk 4 blocks south to 17<sup>th</sup> and E.

Farragut North (Red Line) Exit to Connecticut Ave. NW. Walk south ½ block before continuing south on 17<sup>th</sup> St. NW for 4 blocks.

Federal Triangle (Orange/Blue Line) Exit to 12<sup>th</sup> St. NW. Walk ½ block north to Pennsylvania Ave. NW. Turn left (west) and take Pennsylvania Ave. NW for a block, then a slight left to E St. NW. Continue until you reach the Ellipse.
