For too long, partisan conflicts have blocked progress to address climate change. The Climate Solutions Caucus is a bipartisan group of legislators that are committed to advancing climate solutions. The mission of the caucus is to educate members on economically-viable options to reduce climate risk and to explore bipartisan policy options that address the impacts, causes, and challenges of our changing climate. This caucus draws from all political ideologies and is the first bipartisan body of its kind.
