**Notes:**

**CJS = Commerce Justice Science Subcommittee:** The Committee will consider funding for prevention and response to domestic violence and violence against women - in particular Native women - as part of the Justice Department Budget.

**Int = Interior/ Environment Subcommittee:** The Subcommittee will decide on funding for the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Bureau of Indian Education, Indian Health Service, Contract Support Costs, Road Maintenance and Economic Development programs

**L-HHS = Labor, Health and Human Services and Education Subcommittee:** the subcommittee will decide on funding for educational supports for students in programs ranging from preschool to post-graduate levels, including language preservation programs, and support for tribal colleges and for schools that serve many Native students

**T-HUD = Transportation, Housing and Urban Development Subcommittee:** The Subcommittee will decide on funds for Indian housing and community development.

"Ranking" means the most senior Democrat on the committee.  
Vice-Chair assists the Chair, and is of the same party as the Chair
