### **Quaker Coalition for Uprooting Racism Mission**

We bring together a community of practice of racial justice changemakers to support one another in working within our Religious Society of Friends. These racial justice practitioners model and move toward the vision through embodied spiritual practice and mindful action within and beyond Quaker communities.

The community of practice ...

- builds trusting relationships with one another;
- collectively names and develops strategies to dismantle white supremacy and foster root level change (meaningful rather than performative change); and
- builds skills toward change strategies, actively experiments with them, and brings learnings from those actions back to the group.

## **History of the Coalition**

In 2018, Friends Vanessa Julye and Lucy Duncan connected over a need within the Religious Society of Friends to push for racial justice work. QCUR evolved from their vision of a connected web of Quaker communities challenging racial justice disparities through disruptive action and structural change.
