We, the undersigned community leaders from [your city/state], write with deep concern about the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza, where children face severe malnutrition and lack access to basic necessities like food, baby formula, clean water, and medical supplies. While children in our community prepare to return to school this fall, children in Gaza are simply struggling to survive.

The recently established **Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF)** has significantly **exacerbated suffering by diminishing and weaponizing the flow of aid.** The GHF is not part of the solution—it is part of the problem. We believe that experienced and independent humanitarian organizations must be free to deliver lifesaving assistance without obstruction.

We urge you to **co-sponsor** [H.Res.473 in the House or S.Res.224 in the Senate] and to make a public statement opposing the GHF and the weaponization of aid. In addition, we ask you to call the White House or the State Department to insist on unfettered access of humanitarian aid into Gaza. A single call from your office could help save countless lives.

Our request is not for additional U.S. funding or resources, but simply for unfettered access for independent humanitarian organizations to deliver aid freely. This is a moment to show leadership and compassion, reflecting the values that unite our nation.

We would welcome the opportunity to meet with you or your staff to discuss how we can work together to ensure lifesaving aid reaches children and families in Gaza. We hope you will join us in speaking out for the most vulnerable, and we invite you to join a conversation with the leaders signing this letter.

Thank you for your attention to this urgent humanitarian need and for your service to our community.
