

Urge Congress to Send Aid, Not Arms to Gaza

As we enter the final month of our 2025 campaign to send Aid, Not Arms to Gaza, we have important wins to celebrate and urgent work still ahead.

In July, Congress took an historic step: for the first time, a majority of Senate Democrats voted to block weapons to the Israeli government. The Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF) has been dismantled. All living hostages have been returned. And while violence sadly continues, both Hamas and the Israeli government remain publicly committed to the ceasefire.

Yet we remain stuck in phase one of the peace plan with a fragile ceasefire that has not completely stopped ongoing violence. Humanitarian aid is entering Gaza, but at levels far below what is needed. Winter rains have arrived, worsening conditions for families without adequate shelter. In the West Bank, Palestinians face escalating settler violence during the olive harvest. Global attention is drifting, but we must keep Gaza firmly on Congress's agenda.

During this last month of 2025, let's make a renewed push for Aid, Not Arms. When meeting with Republicans, emphasize that calling for increased humanitarian aid and reopening the medical evacuation pathway aligns with President Trump's peace plan and longstanding bipartisan support for the East Jerusalem Hospital Network. With Democrats, highlight the growing momentum to block offensive weapons and the urgency of using our leverage to stop the violence and secure a lasting peace.

Let's try to get one more lobby visit, LTE, or postcard event in before the year ends!

Ask your Dem Legislators to...

Co-sponsor the Block the Bombs Act and support Joint Resolutions of Disapproval, make public statements on aid.

Ask your GOP Legislators to...

Make a public statement calling for aid access to Gaza, make a public statement and/or 3 calls to reopen the medical evacuation pathway to the East Jerusalem Hospital Network (EJHN).
