

Call Your Senators to Say: Don't Sell Saudi Arabia Weapons of Mass Starvation

Your senators will vote the week of June 12 on whether to block bombs to Saudi Arabia, which are being used to kill civilians in Yemen. Your calls to the Senate are crucial to ensure the Senate sends a strong message to challenge this deadly war. Blocking the sale would prevent the U.S. from aiding and abetting the bloodshed in Yemen that has killed over 10,000 Yemeni civilians and left 7 million Yemenis hungry.

1. Dial the Capitol switchboard.

Dial 1-855-68-NO-WAR (1-855-686-6927), where you will be directed to provide your zip code to identify your state/district, and will be automatically connected to the offices of your legislators.

2. Ask your senator to vote for S.J. Res 42 to block bombs to Saudi Arabia.

Please call both of your senators. Every vote will make a difference to block the bombs. Call script:

Hi my name is [NAME] and I'm a voting constituent from [CITY/STATE]. I'm calling to urge the senator to vote in support of S.J. Res 42, the Murphy-Paul-Franken legislation to block bombs to Saudi Arabia. In a war that has killed over 10,000 Yemeni civilians, the US should stop fueling the indiscriminate killing of civilians and instead should push for a peaceful solution to end the war. I look forward to your response.
