


## Saudi-Led Coalition Continues to Target Civilians in Yemen in 2017


In the first three months of 2017 alone, the Saudi-led coalition hit 362 civilian, civil infrastructure, or economic infrastructure targets in Yemen.





## Among strikes for which the target is known, 43% were non-military targets.

Of these, 15% were civilian structures, 13% were civil infrastructure, and 10% were economic infrastructure. Schools, a medical facility, and a cultural heritage site were also targeted.



The Saudi-led coalition hit 130 civilian targets in Yemen between January and March 2017. Targets included residences, vehicles, markets, and mosques.



Data is from January 1, 2017 to March 31, 2017 and is the latest available. Data was collected by the <u>Yemen Data Project</u>, self-described as an "independent data collection project aimed at collecting and disseminating data on the conduct of the war in Yemen, with the purpose of increasing transparency and promoting accountability of the actors involved."
